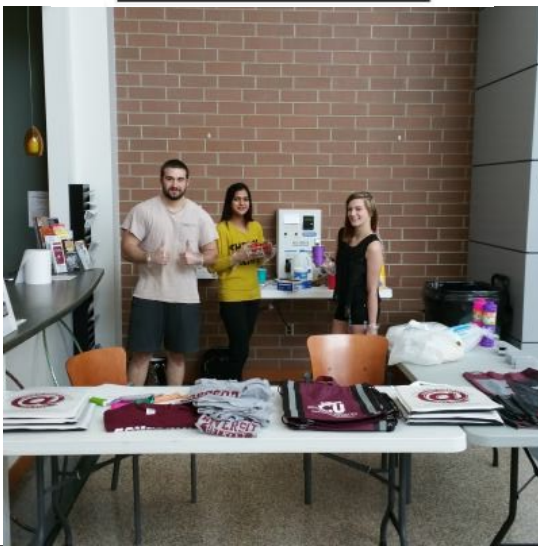


Concord University Students Organize and Sponsor
